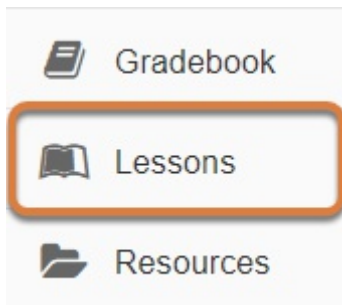


How do I add a VoiceThread link to a lesson page?

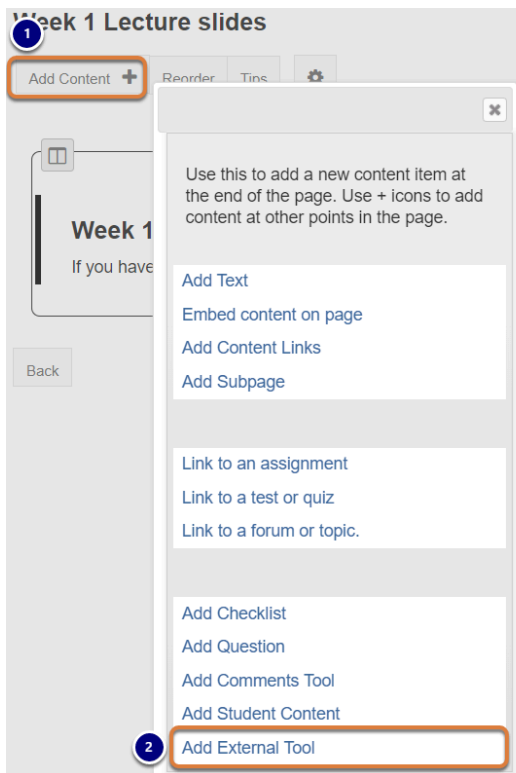
VoiceThreads are interactive slideshows that you create by uploading and linking documents, pictures, videos, and/or audio files. You can add links to individual VoiceThreads or collections of VoiceThread content on lesson pages to increase engagement with media.

Go to Lessons.



Select the **Title** of the lesson page (e.g., **Lessons**, **Activities**, **Week: 1**) from the Tool Menu in your site.

Select Add Content, then Add External Tool.



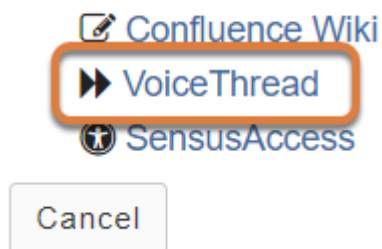
1. Select the **Add Content** tab.
2. In the window that pops up, select **Add External Tool**.

Select the VoiceThread link.

1. Enter a *Tool Title*. This is the text of the link that will appear on the lesson page. For accessibility, you should use [meaningful text](#) to describe your link.
2. Select **Save**.

On the *VoiceThread Setup* page, select the button that corresponds to the type of link to create. Options include:

1. **Course View:** Display all VoiceThread content that has been shared with members of this UVACollab site. The VoiceThreads displayed to each individual who visits the link will depend on their permissions (e.g., in **Course View**, students will only be able to access content that has been shared with the entire class, while instructors will also be able to access student assignment submissions).
2. **Home:** Display the **VoiceThread Home** page for each individual who visits the link (all *VoiceThread* content that person can access). This option is not recommended for course sites, as instructors and students may be confused about where to find content for their course when accessing their **VoiceThread Home** page.
3. **Individual VT:** Display one specific VoiceThread.
4. **Assignment Builder:** Create a graded VoiceThread assignment, where students are required to create their own VoiceThread, watch, and/or comment on VoiceThreads created by others. For additional steps to create an assignment, see [How do I add a VoiceThread assignment to a lesson page?](#)




Note: The type of link **cannot be changed** later, but you may create additional VoiceThread links as needed on your lesson page(s).

Link to an individual VoiceThread.

Selecting the **Course View** or **Home** option will create the link with no additional setup required. See below for steps to link to an individual VoiceThread.

Select an individual VoiceThread to link.

After choosing the **Individual VT** option, you will be taken to the *Select VoiceThread* page, where you will be presented with a list of VoiceThreads you own.

1. Select the **Title** of the VoiceThread to link.
2. Select **Share with Class**.

Note: Alternatively, you may use the **Create new VoiceThread** link to add a new VoiceThread and link to it, or select **Add a VoiceThread by share link or id** to link to a VoiceThread created by someone else that has been shared with you.
